Mattos Black and White Parsha Pictures for Day School

Grade Level: Early Childhood-Early Elementary

Description:

Beautifully illustrated pictures depicting parsha scenes from the week which clearly illustrate the main events/mitzvos in each week's parsha. These pictures lend themselves to being used for a variety of activities and visual review. Each picture is labeled with the appropriate pasuk from the Chumash cited with the exact source. These pictures are geared towards early education and lower elementary classes.

Goals/Objectives:

Students will use the pictures as a means of varied visual review of the parsha.

Instructions:

- 1. Print out each of the pictures on separate pages.
- 2. Color and laminate if desired.
- 3. Use sheets as coloring sheets which review the parsha.

Variations:

- Print out the pictures and hang in the classroom for the teacher to use as a visual aid when teaching the parsha.
- Have children label different parts of the picture, either naming the event/people depicted in the picture.
- Put magnetized tape on the backs of the pictures and have the children arrange the pictures in sequential order.
- Send the pictures home each week for the parents to review the parsha with their children over Shabbos.
- Compile all the pictures from each parsha into a booklet for each sefer and keep in the classroom for the students to flip through for review.
